4 The authorization shall be in force for period from 27/12/2023 to 30/11/2028 .

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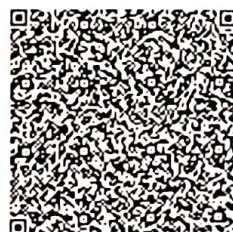
The authorization is subject to the following general and specific conditions :

A. General conditions of Authorization

1. The authorised person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorisation.
4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
5. The person authorised shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorisation is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time;
6. The person authorised shall comply with the provisions outlined in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on "Implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty"
7. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.
8. The imported hazardous and other wastes shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its clean-up operation.
9. The record of consumption and fate of the imported hazardous and other wastes shall be maintained.
10. The hazardous and other waste which gets generated during recycling or reuse or recovery or pre-processing or utilisation of imported hazardous or other wastes shall be treated and disposed

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of as per specific conditions of authorisation.

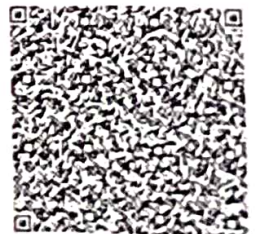
11. The importer or exporter shall bear the cost of import or export and mitigation of damages if any.
12. An application for the renewal of an authorisation shall be made as laid down under these Rules.
13. Any other conditions for compliance as per the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
14. Annual return shall be filed by June 30th for the period ensuring 31st March of the year.

B. Specific Conditions

- 5 That this authorization shall cease to be valid & shall be liable to be revoked without any further notice in case of refusal/expiry of consent to operate under the provisions of Water(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act,1974 and Air(Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act,1981 by the State Board.
- 6 That the quantities of hazardous & other waste under different categories as mentioned in condition no.-03 for pre-processing plant may vary, as per the availability of waste, however total quantity of hazardous & other waste to be procured during the year shall not exceed @20,000 TPA for pre-processing plant.
- 7 That facility will provide adequate storage capacity of runoff during rainy season without the catchment area of premises.
- 8 That it will be ensured that no rain water enters the stabilization shed. Also, entire waste water generated will either be reused in stabilization/compaction or solar evaporated. No industrial effluent/leachate will be discharged on land or into stream or well or in sewer inside or outside the premises.
- 9 That no recycling or processing of hazardous waste covered under schedule IV shall be carried without prior valid registration with Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi (CPCB)/Competent Authority as recycler / re-refiner of Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016.
- 10 That this authorization shall be valid subject to valid consent to operate under the provisions of Water (Prevention Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 issued by the State Board.
- 11 That in case of any expansion or change in process or product or change in process or product or change in mode/ practice of disposal of hazardous waste or its quantity, industry shall obtain fresh Authorization.

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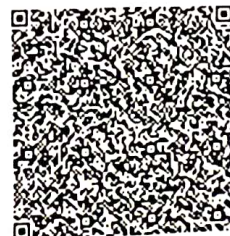
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- 12 The operator shall develop the further cells strictly in accordance with the guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board for criteria for hazardous waste after approval of the design from State Pollution Control Board under rule 18 of the Rules.
- 13 The operator shall carry out leakage tests in solar evaporation ponds once in six month.
- 14 The operator shall comply the guidelines issued by CPCB for storage of hazardous waste and other guidelines issued time to time.
- 15 The operator shall comply the Protocol for Performance Evaluation and Monitoring of the Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage disposal Facilities including Common Hazardous Waste incinerators, issued by CPCB.
- 16 That the operator will comply with all the conditions laid down under site clearance letter dt. 7.1.2008 issued by Department of Environment. Consent to establish letter dt. 18.09.2009, Environmental Clearance letter dt. 15.09.2008.
- 17 That the disposal quantity of hazardous waste against each category may vary, however total quantity disposed should not exceeds the total capacity of cell V & Cell VI i.e. 308062 MT.
- 18 That after issuance of this authorization earlier authorization issued vide order no. RPCB/HWM/2021-2022/HSW/HSW/48 dated 07/01/2022 & order no. RPCB/HWM/2022-2023/HSW/HSW/52 dated 31/03/2023 shall be treated as null and void.
- 19 The authorization is subject to the conditions stated at Annexure "A" enclosed with the authorization letter and the such conditions as may be specified in the Rules for the time being forced under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 20 The unit has to display and maintain the data online outside the factory main gate in Hindi & English both on a 6'X 4' display board in the manner & format prescribed at Annexure "B" and the report of the Compliance along with photograph shall be submitted to this office & Regional Office, time to time.
- 21 That the annual reports/returns in the form prescribed under the Rules shall be submitted to the Board by 30th June of every year and records of hazardous waste Generation, handling & management shall be maintained according to the provisions of the Hazardous Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and shown & submitted to the Board as and when asked for.
- 22 The hazardous waste should not be stored for a period beyond 90 days, failing which the authorization shall deemed to be revoked.

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- 23 It shall be ensured that the Hazardous waste is handled, managed & disposed of strictly in accordance with the Hazardous and Other Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016. Non compliance of the Rules or any of the conditions contained in the authorization shall be tantamount to automatic cancellation/revocation of the authorization.
- 24 The operator of the facility shall liable to comply any other conditions as per the guidelines issued by the MoEF or CPCB or State Board related to collection, disposal, reception, storage & treatment of hazardous waste.
- 25 That this revised authorization letter shall supercede the earlier authorization letter no 2023-2024/HSW/HSW/122 / 6218-6220 dated 27/12/2023
- 26 That this Authorization is being issued under the provisions of Hazardous and Other Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 from the environmental angle only, and does not absolve the project proponent from the other statutory obligations prescribed under any other law or any other instrument in force. The sole and complete responsibility, to comply with conditions laid down in all other rules for the time-being in force, rests with the industry/unit/project proponent.
- 27 That this Authorization shall not, in any way, adversely affect or jeopardize the legal proceeding, if any, instituted in the past or that could be instituted against you by the State Board for violation of the provisions of the Act or the Rules made thereunder.
